



Dear Parent/Carer

As you may be aware, there are conversations happening in the media regarding the potential opening of schools during the summer holidays.

It would appear only fair to give parents as much notice as possible as to what may be happening with schools in and around Maryport. As yet, schools have not had any notification as to what the government plans may be for the summer – we tend to find things out during the daily TV updates just as you do.

That said however, one or two things are clear. Schools in the Maryport area have agreed they WILL NOT be open during the up and coming summer holiday; not even for the children known as priority group one, including key workers and vulnerable children. This includes the following schools – Ellenborough and Ewanrigg Infants, Grasslot Infants, Netherton Infants, Ewanrigg Juniors, Our Lady and St Patricks Catholic Primary School, Maryport CofE Primary, Richmond Hill Primary, Flimby Primary and Dearham Primary.

Schools may be able to signpost parents to activities to help support families during the summer and we will do all we can to notify you of any potential summer holiday clubs that other agencies may be running etc but please take this email as notification that the above schools will not be operational/open during summer 2020.
