

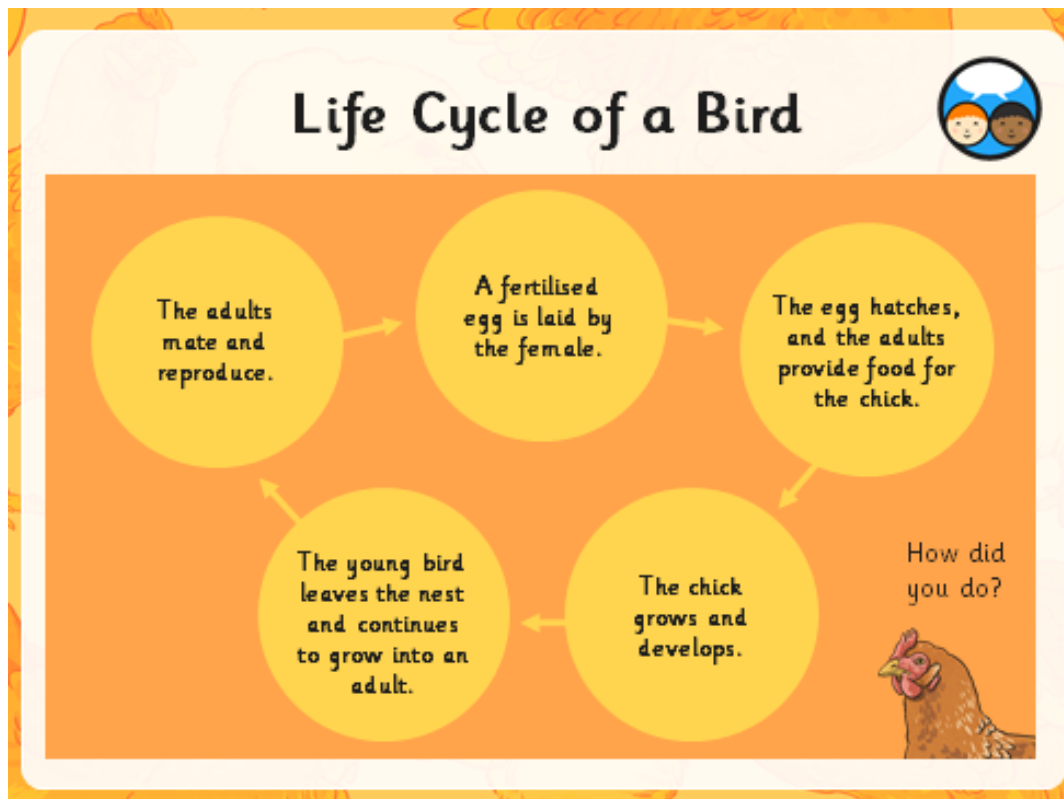
## *Week Commencing 11<sup>th</sup> May 2020*
