Phonics

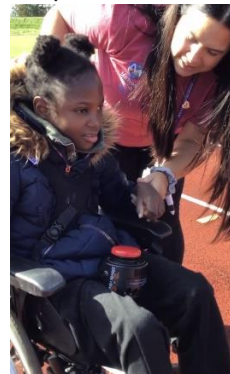
Huge congratulations to Rhyannan and the staff team who have had their practice in phonics teaching recognised nationally.
