Lakes 5 visited Millfield to consolidate their learning of the 'splishy splashy' river from their current core text story. There was even some hungry ducks to feed.

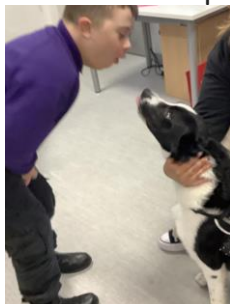
