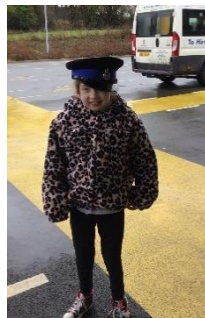


Lakes 8 and 9 had a fab day at Walby Farm.

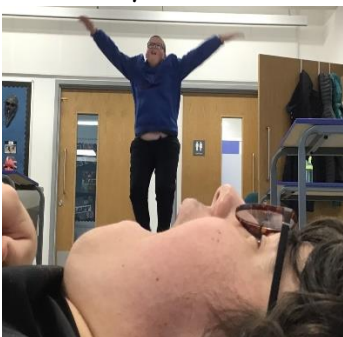
