

Lateral Flow Testing Information for Parents and Carers

In addition to the information booklet contained within the Covid-19 Self-Test Kit we would like to share the following with you for clarity.

General Information

- Testing does not replace the need for following the government guidance of: Hands, Face, Space.
- All testing is voluntary. If your child decides that they want to stop testing that is ok.
- Tests provided by school are intended for secondary age students, we are provided the number of kits that match our school numbers.
- Tests should be completed at home twice a week with 3 or 4 days between testing.
- We recommend that you take a test on Monday and Friday mornings like we do in school.
- Each kit contains 7 tests to cover the period over the Easter break.

Using the Covid-19 Self-Test Kit

- A simple instructional video on administrating the test is available on YouTube https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Q6rdYgA-2IA&list=PLvaBZskxS7tzQYIVg7lwH5uxAD9UrSzGJ&index=2 as well as a guide in each kit.
- Avoid eating or drinking for 30 minutes prior to taking the test as it may affect the result.
- Read and follow the instructions carefully before you start the test
- Swabbing can be done as throat and nose or if this is not possible a double nose swab is also effective and may be easier to do.
- Results will be ready in 30 minutes. You must wait for 30 minutes even if you think you have a result before that. Try not to wait much longer than 30 minutes to read the test as it may affect the end result.







Results of the Test

- The results appear as lines (Page 14 of the information booklet in your test kit) and is as follows:
 - **One line** next to **C** means that the test has worked and the result is negative.
 - Two lines; one next to C and another next to T means that the test has worked and the result is positive. These lines may be faint but it is still a positive result.
 - No lines or one line next to T means the test has not worked and is invalid/void. Read the information or watch the video again and try a new test.

What to Do Next...

- A positive result (two lines) means your child and your household must now self-isolate and follow the Government Guidance: https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/covid-19-stay-at-home-guidance
- Positive results must be reported immediately to school and senior leaders will take any necessary action.
- All home test kit results must be reported to NHS track and trace online at www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result. You will need the QR or the ID number from the test strip you have used.
