European Day of Language on Monday was a great success. Classes enjoyed a day of different foods, arts and customs from different countries.

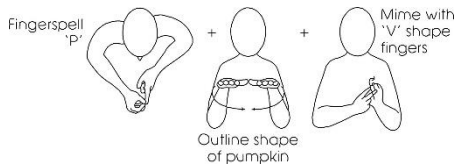
Rights Respecting School

We have achieved our Bronze Rights Respecting School's award and are working towards achieving Silver.

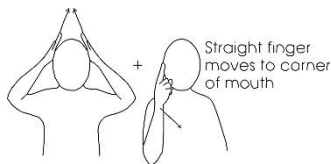
Halloween

Sadly, we will not be having a Halloween disco in school this year, but ahead of this, Sue Oglanby has produced some signs to learn.

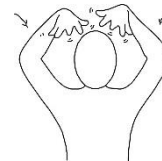

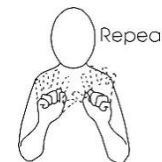
Pumpkin

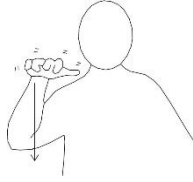

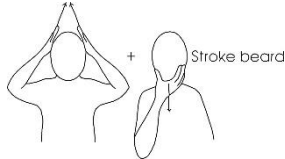
