



Remote Education Provision after schools reopen on 8th March 2021:

This information is intended to provide clarity and transparency to pupils and parents or carers about what to expect from remote education after the return of all pupils on 8th March 2021 but if their child remains at home.

What should my child expect if they are not in school?

For those pupils who are shielding, or who remain at home – class teachers are responsible for setting activities and involving pupils in the class life of their peers.

For older pupils - they will receive work via post and share their work for marking with the class teacher so that this contributes to ongoing assessment.

Where possible, zoom / teams will be used to maintain contact between pupils and their peers. This has been very successful during wider lockdown

Pupils receive their learning by a variety of platforms – no child is disadvantaged by non access to digital platforms.

Pupils receive their work either via:

- Dojo
- Text
- Email
- Paper copies dropped off or posted out

Welfare calls / messages will continue to be made weekly by the teacher where any issues including the delivery of remote education can be discussed.
