Use the table to workout which tasks you have completed in class and which you need to do. For each lesson read the appropriate pages from the information booklet and/or information sheets and complete the worksheet.

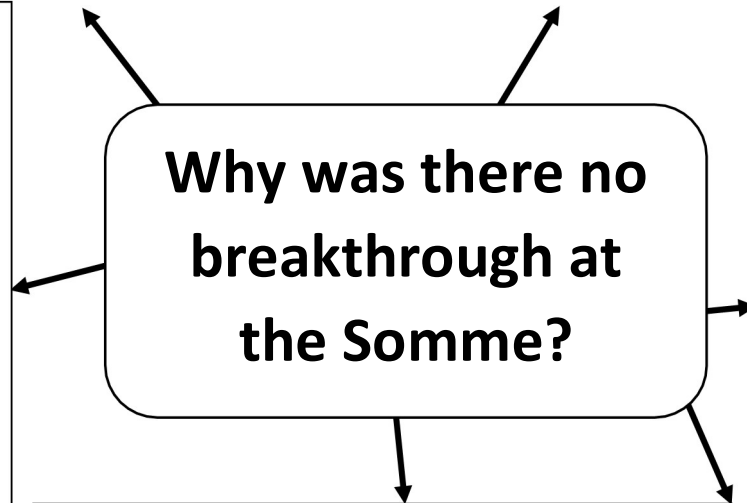



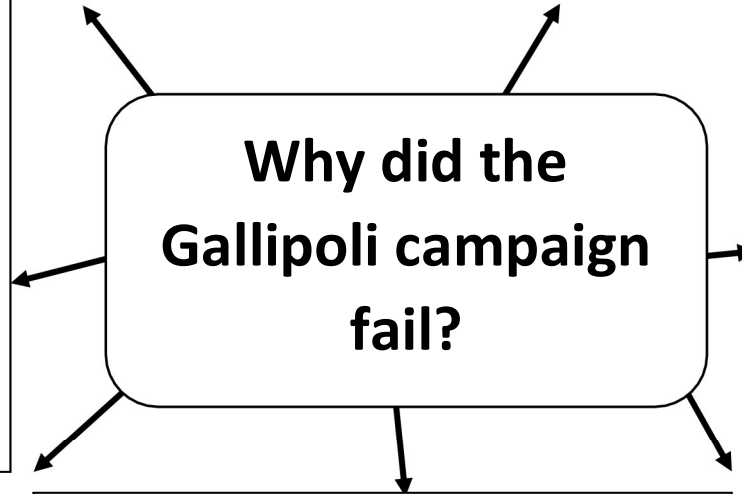
