




# Clair at the Funfair



It was hot. Clair sat on a chair to put on a pair of red flip-flops.




Then, she brushed her short hair and put in a clip.


At the rear of a shed, there lived a family of earwigs. There were three dear little children that had been born at the start of the year.

The smallest, called Sid, was clearly different: he had a beard and two big ears! The mother earwig always kept the children near.





When she reached a nearby bush, she could hear something. She put on her glasses and saw Sid. He was stuck. His beard was stuck on a thorn!














#### The Mixture in the Picture




Hure was ill. In fact, he kept being sick. He had a temperature and felt too ill to get up from his bed.




The doctor sent him to bed with a pill. The pill did not help Hure and he still felt ill.




He went to see the doctor and sat in his room. In the doctor's room, on his desk, was a picture.
