Matching

You will need a collection of objects made up of identical pairs. These could be socks, wellington boots, Noah's Ark animals, etc. Muddle up the items so the pairs aren't together. Ask your child to match the objects into pairs. Encourage your child to talk about why they have matched certain objects together.



Using any construction (Lego, building blocks...) ask your child to build towers that match. Do they look the same? Do the towers always need exactly the same blocks?

Please take pictures of your child doing the matching activities and put them on tapestry!

Sorting

Go on an autumn hunt and collect as many leaves, acorns and pine cones to create a seasonal collection.

Encourage your child to explore the different ways that they can be sorted. Start by using one criteria to make 2 sets. For example, leaves/ not leaves, round/ not round, red/ not red.
