Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to inform you that in year 11's CPR (Citizenship, Philosophy and RE) lessons, they will be studying Sex and Relationships education. This learning will take place in the Spring term.

During the unit, students will cover topics including (but not limited to):

- How to identify healthy and unhealthy relationships
- Some laws regarding relationships, such as that some types of behaviour (e.g. violence and coercive behaviour) are criminal
- What sexual harassment and sexual violence are and why these are unacceptable
- How sexually explicit materials can cause damage to the way people see themselves and how they behave
- The laws surrounding 'sexting' and 'revenge porn', as well as the potential emotional implications on those involved
- How to recognise consent and identify whether consent has been given in a range of circumstances
- Female Genital Mutilation (FGM)
- Honour-based violence
- The differences between forced and arranged marriage
- What behaviours are acceptable in relationships and the respect with which they should treat others and expect to be treated
- That they have the choice to delay sex or enjoy intimate relationships without sex
- Contraception
- The impact of pregnancy and bringing up a baby

Lessons have been developed to comply with the latest guidance from the Department for Education and will be taught in line with Mayfield's SRE policy, which can be viewed on our website.
