Preparation for Learning is a homework programme which provides students with key skills.

Students receive 3/4 projects each half term which must be completed at home. Each project has a task sheet which breaks the task down into manageable chunks and also a mark scheme so students are aware how they are progressing. The purpose of the projects is to develop extended writing, literacy skills, independence, time management and a love of the subject they are studying. In addition to this, student will receive maths and mfl homework every lesson to embed the skills they have learnt that day in lesson and PE will insist upon attendance at extracurricular sports clubs
