Monday	Drama Club	Drama club is run by Jo from Manic Stage productions. These sessions include drama games and exploration of script and devised pieces.
	Creative Writing	Senior students come into the library and work on their Creative Writing skills, learning more about writing theory and getting constructive feedback on their work to grow as writers.
	Rock Band	Pupils will have an opportunity to practice and learn skills on instruments and play together as a band, with one of our peripatetic teachers.
	Homework Club	Use the computers and get support with completing your homework.
Tuesday	Dance Club	Dance club is run by Manic Stage productions and is a great opportunity to explore different styles of dance and develop your skills.
	Football (PITC)	This football club is for all pupils in year 7 and 8 and is run by Portsmouth in the community coaches. It is an active and fun club to develop football skills.
	Art Club (Year 7)	An opportunity for pupils to explore their art skills outside of lesson time.
	Stem Club	This is a science club which encourages students to carry out experiments and explore scientific phenomena. It also helps build investigative skills and allows students to explore science out of the classroom.
	Sustainability	This is an enterprise opportunity for students interested in STEM and the Environment. Competing against 24 other southern schools to create a new concept/prototype that can, simply put, help save the planet.
	Maths Drop In (Yr 7)	Maths Drop in is for Year 7s who are struggling with their Maths. This can be for support with their HW or with support with what is being taught in class.
Wednesday	Football (Year 7 Only)	Open to both boys and girls, football training includes skill development and matches. These sessions are used to help identify players for the school team.
	Triathlon Club	A fitness club when students will look to improve their performance in running, cycling, and swimming. Entry to local competitions will follow in the future
	Art Club (Year 8)	An opportunity for pupils to explore their art skills outside of lesson time.
	Polyglot Languages Club	An opportunity for pupils to learn and explore new languages in a relaxed environment.
	Library Club	Students come to the library and help shelve books and create displays, or they can go on the computers to do their homework.
Thursday	Trampolining	Pupils take turns to develop their personal skill range, using several different body parts to land on the Trampoline. They also learn and appreciate the importance of safety.
