

Year 8 School Camp June 2020

Tile Barn – New Forest



The school is looking to re-establish a tradition of a KS3 Senior school Camp. We have a provisional booking for Monday 8th June through till Friday 12th June at Tile Barn in Brockenhurst. This outdoor adventure experience will be offered to all our current year 8 pupils. The trip will be activities based with a number of different subject areas contributing to the carousel programme. Each student will attend camp for 3 days and 2 nights with a split week. One band of students will attend Monday am to Wednesday pm and the other band Wednesday am to Friday pm. Our aim is to keep cost to a minimum and enable all students to attend.

The trip includes the following:

- Travel to and from the camp site (coach)
- 2 nights' accommodation – Camping
- 3 days activities programme
- All food for the 3 days included

Reasons for reintroduction:

- Improve KS3 Outdoor Education Provision – PE Curriculum
- Improve cross curriculum themes for KS3 students prior to starting GCSEs
- Link to Duke of Edinburgh Award programme
- Link to enterprise so students are connected with raising the finance on a project
- It's an excellent experience to broaden their school life experience

Finance

Basic Cost = £70 per pupil

Initial Deposit required from every pupil = £10 per pupil

To cover the remaining £11000 required for the trip to run, we will be challenging the pupils to raise this money through sponsorship and enterprise activities. By Friday 3rd April we will know how much money we have raised and will be able to inform parents of the remaining balance. If we raise the full amount there will be no additional cost. If we raise £8000 there will be a balance of £17 per pupil to pay.

- We will support students through their PSHE programme and linked to Business Enterprise we are hoping to run a number of school events to raise money for the trip.
- We will actively encourage students to fund raise and raise sponsorship to support each other and enable the whole year group to attend.
- There will be prizes and awards for those that can promote the best enterprise initiatives and raise the most finance through working together in house teams. We are all working together – The more we raise the smaller the final balance will be.

We would like all year 8 students to go on the Senior School Camp. Can parents please complete the return slip below and a £10 deposit using the Tucasi payment system. Any remaining monies to be paid will be due by Friday 22nd May 2020. The aim of the trip is to take all year 8 students. It would be disappointing if your child's attendance, behaviour or attitude drops below the required school standards as their place on this trip may be withdrawn.
