### Careers Spotlight Diagnostic Radiographer

Diagnostic Radiographers use a range of imaging technology and techniques to diagnose a patient's condition. They use X-rays, ultrasound, CT scans and MRI scans to view bones and organs. You could work in different departments such as A&E, in theatre, outpatients or on wards.

Starting salaries are around £23,000 and as an experienced radiographer you could earn up to £36,000.

You would need to complete a level 3 course at college and then gain a degree in Diagnostic Radiography at university.

You can do further training to specialize in a particular area
