

HT Message – Mr. David Jeapes

You may be aware that the Government have now confirmed that children aged 12 to 15 will be offered a single dose of the Pfizer vaccine as part of the wider vaccination programme. Please note that the oversight of this is with the school immunisation team. I appreciate that parents, carers and pupils will want more information about the benefits of this vaccine and clarity around the issue of giving, or withholding, consent. At this time the school awaits guidance around these matters – please rest assured we will publish this as it becomes available.

Please be aware that during the summer break, the Government have taken the decision to extend the provision of the nasal flu vaccine to include all children, this is a separate and different vaccine to the COVID 19. More information about this can be found here:

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Dear Parents,

We recently sent out information regarding upcoming Nasal Flu Immunisation's in Schools. Unfortunately, we have been informed that some of the links have been difficult to negotiate, therefore we are sending out this useful information.

Please find the below link which you will need to use to access the In Health e-consent system: -

If this does not open, please copy and paste the link above into your search engine.

Once you click START you will then be prompted for the Unique School LEA Code which you will have received in your previous parent letter.

If classes are not appearing for you to select, please select Year Group again.

Once you have opened the form, you will be given an option to have a nasal spray or injection. Please can we ask that you select the nasal spray vaccination unless your child is unable to have this due to Medical or Religious reasons. The nasal spray contains porcine gelatine which acts as a stabiliser.

Please also complete the online form even if you do not want your child to receive the vaccine.

Please also refer to your previous parent letter for consent close date and school session date information. If you submit consent after this time your child will be unable to be given the immunisation in school but will be offered a clinic appointment.

Please ensure you inform the school and the Solent NHS School Aged Immunisation Team if there are any changes in your child's health within the 10 days before the vaccination date. For example: changes in your child's Asthma such as increased use of inhalers, change of inhalers and active wheezing. If your child has taken a course of oral steroids in the 14 days before the vaccination date it is important that you let us know.
