# Welcome to the thirteenth edition of the Mayfield Messenger since lockdown.

This week we welcomed back Year 5 and 10. I am delighted to report that the children have settled very quickly into our routines and excellent progress was made. Many teachers commented to me on the maturity and focus of our pupils and their resilience and respectful manner.

As you may be aware, we intend to welcome back all Primary Section Year Groups. The detail behind this, is as follows:

### Primary School Bubble Provision Days, every:

- Year R Thursday and Friday until the end of term;
- Year 1 Monday and Tuesday until the end of term;
- Year 2 Monday and Tuesday from Monday 22nd June until the end of term;
- Year 3 Thursday and Friday from Thursday 25th June until the end of term;
- Year 4 Monday and Tuesday from Monday 29th June until the end of term;
- Year 5 Thursday and Friday until the end of term.

Parents and pupils should line up, observing social distancing, and can drop off between 8.30am and 9.00am. Collection is from the same gate between 3.00pm and 3.30pm. Please observe social distancing, the entrance and exit gates are as follows:

Year R and Year 2 - the green infant gate closest to the main reception;

Year 1 and Year 5 - the junior gate on Mayfield Road;

Year 3 and 4 - the infant gate on Mayfield Road.

The booking system is now open for children joining 3 and 4. In order to make life a little easier for parents, we have decided that if your child is in Year R, 1, 2 or 5 and they have already booked into Primary "Bubble School", we will assume that they will continue to attend and there is no need to rebook them on.
