<u>Confirmation of Strike day (Wednesday 5th and Friday 7th July) - Partially closed</u> As you may be aware that the National Education Union (NEU) has announced two additional strike days in schools in England on Wednesday 5th and Friday 7th July. As I have written previously, members of the unions are not required to let employers know ahead of time whether they intend to strike. However, based on the previous and current information, I have made the decision to <u>partially close</u>. As always, the decision to partially close has not been taken lightly. Again, I do realise that this will cause difficulties for parents and carers and I wanted to give you as much notice as possible. The school will be open to;

- Year 8 and 9 selected pupils for their Exact test which only takes 1 hour. Mr Clark-Lyons will send a message saying what time that the children will need to be here for.
- Some year 10 students will be asked to come in for subject specific
- Pupils with a current Education, Health and Care Plan
- There will be an online form where parents can sign up for a free school meal which can be collected from the main reception between 1.35 and 2.00pm

Summer food vouchers

This summer, Portsmouth City Council (PCC) has committed to provide a food voucher to all families of children in reception through to year 11, including children who will be starting school in September 2023, eligible for benefits-related free school meals (FSM).

Families will receive a £70 voucher for every eligible child attending school in Portsmouth this term or registered to start school in September. The funding for these vouchers is from the Household Support Fund (HSF) from the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) and is intended to help families with the rising cost of living.

We are also able to create vouchers for early years' children who are due to start Reception in September 2023. Parents and carers will need to apply for Free School Meals by Friday 30 June 2023.

Uniform Donations

As we are coming to the end of the year Friends of Mayfield are looking for donations of uniform for our Pre-Loved Uniform shop. If you have any items which you have outgrown and are willing to donate, please bring to pupil services or main reception.


