<u>Catch – Up</u>

I am very pleased to confirm that our staff have undertaken some focussed work around "catch up" for all pupils in Years R to 11 from September 2020. Our approach can be summarised as follows:

- Provision of a Summer School for selected pupils in our Primary Section;
- · Opening of additional SEN provisions including dedicated SEN teaching staff;
- Additional ELSA time for pupils across the school to support their mental health;
- Delivery of 'one to one' tuition sessions for identified pupils;
- Daily 'catch up clubs' running from 3:30pm to 4:30pm for identified Primary Section pupils;
- Daily 'Period 6' sessions for identified Senior Section pupils.
