# Unloc/Verizon 'Changemaker Day' Business and Enterprise trip to Portsmouth Guildhall on Wednesday June 7th 2023

On Wednesday, twenty of our students from across Years 8, 9 and 10 participated in the UNLOC business- and enterprise-themed 'Changemaker Day' event.

The day comprised a series of sessions that were designed to inspire young people to explore what it means to be a 'changemaker', by widening their career horizons, and putting their entrepreneurial skills to the test through a series of social business challenges.

After introductions and ice-breaker challenges, our students then listened to inspiring talks from our two Verizon business mentors. We then had to complete workshops that were designed to boost some of the skills relevant to setting and running many forms of business. Our students then undertook the 'Changemaker Challenge', where teams had to build an entrepreneurial solution to a real-life social issue that was linked to a Verizon CSR Pillar, comprising either 'human prosperity', 'climate change', or 'digital inclusion'.



The Friends of Mayfield Summer Fete is being held on <u>Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> July</u>



## This week's successes outside of Mayfield are;


