Welcome back!

Firstly, I hope that you all had a good Summer. Although the weather in the UK during the summer break was typical, there was no doubt that as we returned the sun would come out.

The start of the new academic year began earlier this week for staff, who received training during the first 2 INSET days. The training included safeguarding and behaviour (high expectations), the effective principles of high quality teaching/planning and regulation and neurodiversity to name a few. This work will continue to be our focus and drive for school improvement during this academic year.

The start of the year for pupils began on Wednesday (Year 1 -6, Year 7 and Year 11) with the other year groups returning yesterday (Thursday). The children looked incredibly smart and I would like to thank parents and carers in the support they have shown for ensuring the children have the correct uniform every day.

It has been good to catch up with the children across the school to hear about what they got up to as well as hear about how excited they were about their first day and the new school year (although some were also a little nervous). I was particularly impressed with our Year 7 and Year 11 pupils. Our older pupils demonstrated great responsibility in making sure that the younger pupils were able to navigate their timetables as well as navigate the school building. As a result, the children were more confident by the end of the day and ready for Tuesday. We now look forward to welcoming our Year R pupils and families next week.


In addition to this, we would like to invite all of our current Year R to Year 6 families to show them the children's classrooms, opportunity to meet the teachers and to see what goes on in primary.

The SEND Review evening which has been promoted will be open to parents and carers from 4pm in the main hall. (Please see above for more information of the evening).






Year 11 Parents Evening, 5th October 2023

Entitled to Free School Meals

The application process is very quick and you normally get a decision the same day. Eligible children in Primary can choose any hot meal from the normal menu. Children in seniors will be credited daily to spend on their cashless accounts which can be used at any of the food outlets.


Year 11 pupil will then have the opportunity to apply for the scholarship.
