The topic will continue with the theme 'winter'. In class we are still looking at various media and materials to create artwork and achieve the children's planned effect. The children are learning to articulate their own ideas and adapt their work if necessary.

Learning intentions linked to class topic:

- Talk through their ideas and help extend critical thinking through asking questions
- Create props to support role play
- Use a variety of writing implements to support mark making.

Letter sound for the week is 'H' -thank you for continuing to create a collage with your children, we use their lovely creations at circle time to support speech sounds. Shortly in class we will be introducing a word wall. Each week we will choose 2 words to put onto our wall from the 'high frequency booklet' which will be sent home in February. These will be put inside your children's book bag. These booklets will only go home with the children who will be starting Reception this September, but our word wall will support all of our children to recognise words and start to blend words together.
