Our children have had another lovely week at school. They have settled into the class routine and have gained a better understanding of the class rules and boundaries. The topic in class is All About Me, we will be looking at similarities and differences between themselves and others, developing their confidence in the use of language when referring about themselves.

Learning Intentions linked to class topic:

- To build confidence and introduce new vocabulary linked to topic
- To recognise similarities and differences between themselves and others,
- Comment and ask questions.
- Count accurately 1-1 correspondence.

In class each week we will have letter sound of the week, to promote speech sounds. The letter for next week will be 'A,' could you create a collage with your children with objects that begin with the letter A, we will share these on Thursday at circle time to promote speech sounds. Homework will be going home weekly, and it is linked to the class topic do not forget to make it fun and give lots of praise. Children love to see their work on display, and it starts conversations building their communication skills.

We create a booklet in class called a Learning Journal, it will include photographs, and your children's work. These will be available for you to take home and contribute towards at the end of the month.
