Re: Mayfield School - Priority School Building Programme

Further to the letter you would have received in November 2017, we are writing to update you on the progress of the Mayfield scheme. You will recall that Mayfield School, with the support of Portsmouth City Council, was successful in obtaining funding from the Education and Skills Funding Agency for the redevelopment of the school to address serious condition issues.


The school, the council, the Education and Skills Funding Agency, and the building contractor have been discussing the accommodation that would be required to best meet the current and future needs of the school, and its staff and pupils. It is vitally important that we get this right, and the process to ensure that all of the requirements have been captured and carefully considered will continue for some weeks yet.

Detailed plans for the building will be shared with our community when the planning application process starts. This would include a series of meetings with different stakeholders including staff, pupils, parents and local residents to view the plans and speak to the council and the contractor. At this point, we are anticipating that this will take place at the end of the spring (likely to be in May 2018).

I will write to you again with details of the different stakeholder meetings nearer the time, once the timings have been confirmed.
