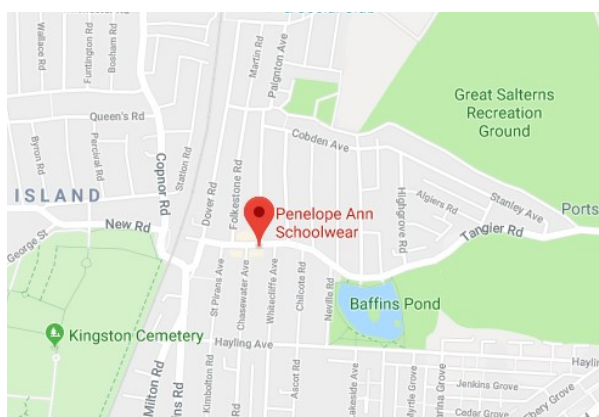

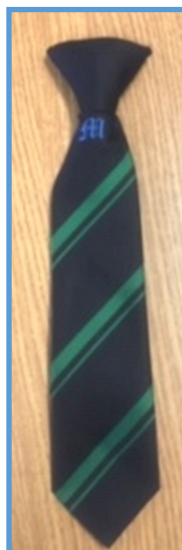

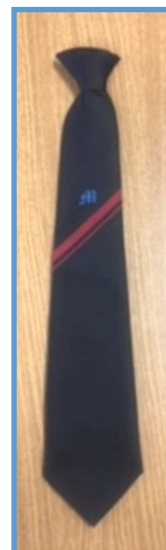
What does the uniform look like?

Year 1-11 fitted PE top in appropriate house colour

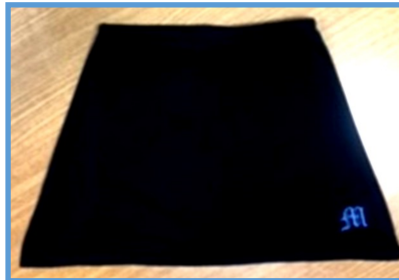


Year 1-11 loose PE top in appropriate house colour

NB—pupils can choose to wear any black jogging bottoms in Years R to 6 and leggings or tracksuit bottoms in Years 7-11.

Trainers must be appropriate for PE activities and not fashion shoes.

Pupils must wear plain, black football socks or sports socks as appropriate

NB—pupils should purchase a tracksuit top in their house colour.

Book bags, school bags and PE bags



These are available from both suppliers and are compulsory for Year R-2. They can be initialised by either uniform supplier.



These are available from both suppliers and can be used in place of the book bag in Years 3-6 should pupils wish.

These are currently optional for Years 7-11.

They can be initialised by either uniform supplier.



These are available from both suppliers and are compulsory for Year 1-6. Year R should have a blue PE bag until Year 1.

They can be initialised by either uniform supplier.

House Colours



School Uniform Rules

The following are the expectations around general uniform standards:

- Socks must be black or white;
- Shoes must be black and able to be polished. They must not be canvas or trainers;
- Hair longer than shoulder length must be tied back;
- Jewellery is limited to one small pair of studs or sleepers in the lobe of the ear;
- False nails and nail varnish are not allowed;
- Coats must be removed whilst inside the building;

Year 7 Suggested Equipment List

Pupils will be checked on the gate every morning to ensure that they are ready for school. As a minimum, pupils must bring with them a:

- Pen;
- Pencil;
- School planner;
- Reading book;

The items below would be useful equipment for all pupils from year 7 onwards:

- Ruler;
- Eraser;
- Calculator;
- Highlighter pen;
- Colouring pens/pencils;
