78%

78% said their communication skills and ability to work with others had improved.

91%

91% said they are now more aware of the 8 main employability skills that employers look for. For example creative problem solving, good work ethic or entrepreneurial thinking.

91%

91% said they have a better idea of how to write a personal profile and put together a CV.

96%

96% said they have a better understanding of how to present themselves at an interview or assessment centre to increase their chances of success.
