Task 1: Choosing a charity

Choose a charity that interests you. This could be a local, national or international charity. Explain why you have chosen the charity that you have.

Task 2: Researching the charity

Research the charity and make notes on

- a. What the charity does
- b. Why the charity was set up
- c. When the charity was set up
- d. How the charity raises money

Task 3: Fundraising

Imagine you were planning to fundraise for this charity. Plan out how you might do this. You should consider:

- Where the fundraising would take place
- Whether it would be a one-off or ongoing fundraiser
- What costs would be involved in setting it up
- How you would tell people about it
- Who you would need to get involved with the fundraiser to make it successful

Task 4: Your own charity

Design your own charity, based on something that you care about or something that you feel needs addressing in our society.

You should include:

- The name, logo and aim of your charity
- Who the charity helps
- How you will advertise your charity
- What equipment you might need to set the charity up and carry out its work, and how you will get the equipment
- How long you think the charity will need to be running for to achieve its aims
- Whether your staff will be paid or volunteers
- How you will raise money for your charity

Task 5: Religious views on charity

Research the Christian story of *The Good Samaritan*. How would this encourage Christians to support charities and act charitably?

Research Zakat. It is one of the five pillars of Islam. How might Zakat impact a Muslim's decision regarding charity?
