"Follow your dreams."

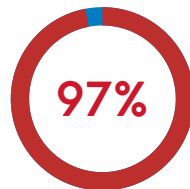
"To have a more open mind about jobs and the options I have."

"That I can be anything I want to be."

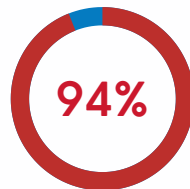
"I've learnt what civil engineering is."

"Don't give up if a job or project goes wrong."

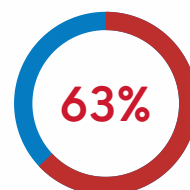
"There are more jobs than you think there are."



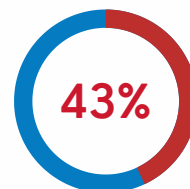
Of students said "I've learnt about job types or careers that I didn't know about before today."
