

GOVERNING BOARD COMMITTEES

CURRICULUM AND PUPIL PROGRESS COMMITTEE

This committee monitors pupil progress and outcomes at all ages. It ensures that the school provides a broad and appropriate curriculum for all pupils including those with additional needs and those from vulnerable groups. The committee also monitors pupil attendance and behaviour. It regularly invites members of the School Council to come to the meeting in order to get direct feedback from students about their views of the school.

SCRUTINY COMMITTEE

The Scrutiny committee allows governors the capacity to consider all aspects of the school in more detail. Examples of items discussed are Behaviour for Learning, Alternative Provision, Bullying, Health and Safety, and the House system. The Full Governing Board has to agree all agenda items.

PERSONNEL, FINANCE AND ESTATES COMMITTEE

The Personnel, Finance & Estates Committee is a committee to review 3 items:-

- Personnel - To assist Mayfield's ethos of providing high quality teaching and learning. through an understanding of Mayfield's resourcing requirements, reviewing staff turnover and to assist and assure new staff are a good match for Mayfield's ethos.
- Finance - To ensure Mayfield spends money wisely and properly, supporting all pupils to raise standards and attainments by use of detailed reviews of budgets, scrutinising specific expenditures and ensuring accountability within the school's finance policy.
- Estates - To ensure Mayfield's infrastructure is managed and maintained to enable all pupils and personnel are safeguarded as well as provided with the best available infrastructure to support quality teaching and learning.

The committee meets once each half term, and helps support the Full Governing Board on updates to key areas specifically around school's budget policy.
