# English - In Reading we are learning...

To understand books by drawing on what they already know or on background information and vocabulary provided by the teacher. To check that the text makes sense to them as they read and correct inaccurate reading.

# English – In Writing we are learning...

To compose a sentence orally before writing it.

To combine words to make a sentence that makes sense.

To punctuate sentences using a capital letter and full stop.

### In Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education we are learning...

To know that I feel special and safe in my class.

Understand the rights and responsibilities within my class.

Know my views are valued.

Recognise how it feels to be proud of an achievement.

# Mathematics – In Number we are learning...

To count on from any starting number to 10.

To count backwards from any starting number up to 10.

To identify one more and one less.

# Mathematics - In Measurement we are learning...

To apply our knowledge of place value, and bonds within 5,6,7 and 8 to the context of money (to 10p in coins) and length (cms).

#### In Science we are learning...

To identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.

Describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals.

# In Relationships and Sex Education we are learning...

Know that I belong to my class.





### In Religious Education, Beliefs and Values we are learning...

To talk about some simple ideas about God and Jesus.

To talk about issues of good and bad, right and wrong arising from stories from the Bible.

### In Geography we are learning...

Use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of their school and its grounds and the key human and physical features of its surrounding environment.

Understand that features are known as human or physical.

#### In Physical Education we learning...

To explore balance, stability and landing safely.

How the body moves differently when running at different speeds.

To change direction and dodging.

To develop tracking & retrieving a ball

To explore sending and receiving with hands and feet to a partner.

#### In French we are learning...

To use everyday greetings in context. Know and join in with familiar French songs.

Listen to the French spoken language. Begin to join in and respond to spoken language through songs and rhymes.

#### In Computing we are learning...

To identify a computer and its main parts.

To log in using our username and password.

To use a mouse in different ways.

To use a keyboard to type on a

computer.

To use the keyboard to edt text.

### In History we are learning...

To identify changes that have happened in history that can impact on today.

# In Art and Design and Design and Technology we are learning...

To make marks in print using different objects, and basic tools. Generate ideas based on simple design criteria and their own experiences, explaining what they could make.

Plan by suggesting what to do next.

#### In Music we are learning...

Talk about feelings created by the music.

Demonstrate good singing posture. Sing, rap, rhyme, chant and use spoken word.

Rehearse and learn to play a simple melodic instrumental part by ear or from simple notation.
