English - Our book studies are...

In Mathematics - Number, we are learning...

About numbers, place value and calculations.

Please see your child's EHC Support Plan for personal targets.

Each child will follow their appropriate curriculum objectives and personal targets.

In Measurement we are learning...

About time.

To communicate about things we do during the day and night.

To respond appropriately about upcoming activities, e.g. lunch time, home time.

To name the days of the week and some of us will be learning to tell the time on an analogue and digital clock.

In Science we are learning...

About all things Colour and Light!

To mix colours, observe change and show awareness of cause-and-effect.

To identify objects from silhouettes, recalling some light sources.

That dark and light are opposites and recognising that objects cannot be seen in darkness

In Physical Education we are learning...

To develop our gross and fine motor skills during O.T sessions.

To take part in regular sensory breaks within class.

With adult support, children will join their peers, in their mainstream class, for outdoor and indoor PE sessions. Please ensure your child has a full PE kit in school for all weather options for the half term.

This term, the Year 5 pupils are swimming on Monday mornings.





In History and Geography we are learning...

To develop a sense of time, sequencing familiar activities in chronological order e.g. daily routines

To demonstrate an understanding of why certain events happened at certain times e.g. Christmas, Diwali

To explore the natural world around them, understanding the effect of the changing seasons, particularly the colours, on the natural world around them.

To use maps and globes to find continents and oceans.

In Life Skills Development we are learning...

To choose a library book that we are interested.

To scan our books so we can take them back to school.

We will visit Cheadle library for some sensory stories.

During our visit, we will be learning to;

Walk safely in small groups, knowing that we need to stop at roads and check before we cross.

In Music and Religious Education, Beliefs and Values we are learning...

To recognise some of the ways people celebrate special times, including the festival of Diwali and Christmas.

To listen and respond to music and songs that help us to celebrate the festivals of Diwali and Christmas

In Art and Computing we are learning...

To explore mixing primary colours to create secondary colours.

To create a piece of artwork linked to Diwali.

To create digital art by controlling the mouse to draw lines and select colours using the art package Dazzle.
