

Very proud silver medallists and well deserved!




















### **NURSERY TRANSITION DAYS**

We are holding a **NON-UNIFORM DAY** to raise money for the VASCULAR EHLERS-DANLOS SYNDROME (vEDS) charity.


All children can wear something RED to school on Friday 17th May for a £1 donation.



Vascular Ehlers-Danlos syndrome (vEDS) is characterized by arterial, intestinal, and/or uterine fragility; thin, translucent skin; easy bruising; characteristic facial appearance (thin vermilion of the lips, narrow nose, prominent eyes); and an aged appearance to the extremities, particularly the hands. It is a serious, rare disease but often underdiagnosed.

Staff and the affected pupil are really well supported by this leading charity, so we would like to say a BIG THANK YOU to them by holding this non-uniform day to raise funds to help them. Thank you.
