Please can all children bring a carrier bag into school next week so that they can take books etc. home.




Children will also be taking home any medication that is held in school next Friday e.g. inhalers.

# Dying for a dip?

Every year people drown in open water around Greater Manchester.

It's not worth the risk, be safe around water.

### Please take care over the Summer if vour child goes near open water.

There are many dangers of swimming in open water. There is no supervision, the water is cold, the water can be deep, there may be hidden currents and you cannot know what lies beneath.

#### What should you do if you get into difficulty?

However you end up in the water, if you end up in difficulty, float to live:

- Tilt your head back, with ears submerged.
- Relax and try to breathe normally.
- Move your hands to help you stay afloat.
- It's okay if your legs sink, we all float differently.
- Spread your arms and legs to improve stability.

If the effects of cold water shock pass and you regain your calm, take the next step to safety. This could be swimming to a safe place, calling for help or holding onto something to help you float.

If you see someone in difficulty in the water remember 'call, tell, throw':

- Call 999 and ask for fire if inland or the coastguard if by the sea. Explain your location clearly and describe any landmarks.
- Tell the struggling person to try to float on their back.
- Throw them something that floats.

### Important Reminders:

#### MEANWOOD SCHOOL UNIFORM STANDARDS

The school uniform at Meanwood is:





- Meanwood Logo School sweatshirt or cardigan OR plain navy jumper, sweatshirt or cardigan
- Black shoes
- In summer, girls may wear a blue gingham dress and boys may wear short grey trousers

For safety reasons, children are not permitted to wear jewellery except plain stud earnings - these will need covering for PE if they cannot be removed by the child.

For indoor PE children need plain dark coloured shorts/leggings and a plain white t-shirt.

For outdoor PE plain dark coloured shorts/leggings, plain white t-shirt and trainers.

For outdoor PE (COLDER MONTHS) plain dark coloured tracksuit/fleece bottoms, plain jumper and

Children will need a pump bag to store their PE kit. Long hair must be tied back for PE.

Children will also need a water bottle and a bag that is brought to school every day to hold items such as a reading book, homework and letters.
