COMMUNICATION FROM SCHOOL



To enable school to communicate efficiently with parents, it is important that your device allows 'push notifications'.

On IOS


When the Arbor App is downloaded you should receive a prompt to receive notifications from Arbor. Make sure that you select Allow to enable school to send push notifications. This will ensure you receive a notification when you have a new In-App message from school.

"Arbor" Would Like to Send You Notifications Notifications may include alerts, sounds and icon badges. These can be configured in Settings.

If you select Don't Allow, you can turn Push Notifications back on at any time by going to settings on your phone.

Do you have a child in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2?

Did you know that all pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free school dinner called a Universal Infant Free School Meal (UIFSM)? This is provided by the government to try to increase the number of children eating good food in schools.

If your infant child currently brings a packed lunch to school you might like to have a look at our menu for next week and choose a meal with them instead.

Just by taking up the offer of UIFSM you will help to boost school's funding. Even if your infant child is entitled to UIFSM, if you think that they are eligible for Free School Meals please apply as this further increases our funding through Pupil Premium. WRAPAROUND CARE

We have now extended our wraparound care provision.

Early Birds Before School Club

This is from 7.45am to 8.45am each day and for £1 per session we offer a healthy breakfast and a range of activities. Children are then escorted to their classroom after the session.

Bookings $\frac{must}{must}$ be made on the Arbor app in advance and must be booked at the latest by 7:15am before the session for that day. Please note that pupils must arrive at the club before 8.15am.

Wise Owls After School Club

The club runs from 3.15pm to 5.30pm every day.

For £6 per session we offer childcare with a healthy snack and drink and a range of activities. Bookings must be made on the Arbor app by 2:30pm the day before the place is required e.g. book by 2:30pm on Tuesday for a place at the club on Wednesday.


Please note that children must be collected by 5.30pm or your child's place may be withdrawn.

Whilst immediate cover cannot be offered, this post will be advertised and recruited to as a matter of urgency.



Thursday, 15 January 2026	Closing date for applications Ensure your reception class application for a primary school is submitted before this date. Otherwise, you will need to apply for a late application.	
Friday, 13 February 2026	Last date for any changes to the address in your application.	
Thursday, 16 April 2026	National offer day.	
Sunday, 10 May 2026	Closing date for Round 2 applications.	
Friday, 5 June 2026	Round 2 offers are sent.	
Saturday, 6 June 2026	Online applications re-open. The online admissions system re-opens for primary school places starting in September 2026.	
Monday, 31 August 2026	Final closing date for applications.

The government (Department for Education) has introduced a new national framework for penalty notices which parent/carers must pay if they take a child out of school during term time, for holidays or unauthorised absence. The changes came into effect for fines issued after 19 August 2024. We urge parents/carers not to interrupt their children's schooling and talk to the office staff before booking leave of absence.
