Please Remember We Are A Nut Free School

Within the last few weeks, we have noticed that items containing nuts are being brought into school in packed lunches and in snacks for after school clubs. **We are a nut free school.**

Some of the products being brought into school are Kinder Bueno's, Kinder Hippos, Nutella biscuits etc. These all do not contain whole nuts but they contain hazelnut cream made with hazelnuts not just flavourings.

We have several children and staff with severe allergies, if they come into contact with any product containing nuts they could have a very serious anaphylaxis reaction.

Please **do not** let your child bring any product containing nuts into school. Thank you.

General School Information

Important - Communication

Most communication to parents/carers from school is sent via email, if you have not been receiving emails from us please contact the school office as soon as possible to check we have the correct email address for you so that you do not miss important updates.



If you have also recently moved house or changed your mobile phone number it is really important that you inform the school office so we can update your child's records in case of an emergency.



Please make sure that collection arrangements are made with children and staff before school each day? We understand that at times circumstances change and accept this cannot be helped but continual change of arrangements is confusing for the children and school staff.

Signing Children Out

All children need to be signed out at the main office if they are leaving for whatever reason during the school day.

If your child is in EYFS/KS1, then you will need to come to the office first to sign them out, please ensure you collect your sign out ticket from the machine to show staff you have signed your child out. Your child will not be allowed to leave school until you show a member of staff the sign out ticket.

If your child is in KS2 then please hand the ticket over to the staff member that brings your child to the school office.

At The Start Of The School Day

Children must be supervised by an adult before class doors are opened at 8.45am. Staff are not able to watch children before this time.

Children must not play on the outdoor gym before or after school.

Absence Procedure

If your child is absent from school, you must contact the school office every day, prior to class registration, to inform us of the reason for absence.
