BOROUGH COUNCIL School fines for unauthorised absence have changed.

The government (Department for Education) has introduced a new national framework for penalty notices which parent/carers must pay if they take a child out of school during term time, for holidays or unauthorised absence. The changes came into effect for fines issued after 19 August 2024. We urge parents/carers not to interrupt their children's schooling and talk to the office staff before booking leave of absence.

School Gateway App: Action needed

Schoolgateway

School Gateway is our parent engagement app that will allow you to pay for school trips/dinner money and communicate with the school at anytime from anywhere.



All school related communication, emails and messages will go through School Gateway. To stay up to date with what's going on at school make sure you download the app for free.

Just search: School Gateway in your App store and download

Your login details will be automatically generated using the contact information school already has, so please make sure the details we hold for you are up to date.



If you think you are entitled to Free School Meals please copy this link into your browser to complete the Rochdale Council Form:

Rochdale Council will process your application (this can take a couple of weeks to process) and they will send you a letter to inform you of the outcome. Please bring a copy of this letter to the school office then we can update your child's record. Please note any school meals taken will need to be paid for until eligibility is confirmed.

It is very important that you check if you are eligible, even if you think you are not, because if you are eligible you will receive vouchers in the school holidays to pay for food at local supermarkets.

Please note: The cost of school dinners has increased by 10p from 4th September 2024.

The new price will be £2.50 per day. The weekly cost will therefore be £12.50.

PRICE INCREASE ALERT •

Please keep a check on your child's dinner money balance via the schoolgateway app. Any pupils owing more than 1 week of dinner money will be unable to choose a lunch on our system and will need to bring a packed lunch from home until payment has been made.

MEANWOOD SCHOOL UNIFORM STANDARDS

The school uniform at Meanwood is:









- Grey skirt or grey trousers
- White shirt or white polo shirt
- Meanwood Logo School sweatshirt or cardigan OR plain navy jumper, sweatshirt or cardigan
- Black shoes
- In summer, girls may wear a blue gingham dress and boys may wear short grey trousers

For safety reasons, children are not permitted to wear jewellery except plain stud earrings - these will need covering for PE if they cannot be removed by the child.

For **indoor PE** children need plain dark coloured shorts/leggings and a plain white t-shirt.

Wise Owls

If you want to book a Wise Owls session the cut off for booking is 3pm. All places must be booked by then.

If you need an emergency session after this time please contact the office but there must be a balance on your account to pay for the session.

Places will not be booked unless you have money available on your account.

You are able to have a balance on your account at any time. You can view and top this up on the app.
