The SEND Advice Line are running some drop-in sessions for SEND advice, in collaboration with Barnardo's SENDIASS Service.

These sessions will be held at Number One Riverside, Smith Street, Rochdale, OL16 1XU. They run one day each month from 9.30am to 11.30am.

Their service is available to Parents, Carers, Young People and Professionals, offering expert advice, guidance, and signposting on all matters related to SEND.

There are also some Family Hub Sessions, which are aimed at giving parents a little extra support with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND).

These sessions will help guide you through the different pathways steps, and processes to ensure that you know where to turn next.

The Family Hub sessions are held in and around Rochdale, Middleton and Heywood and are on various dates.

Again no appointment is necessary.




