

The children were able to touch a snake, a gerbil, a cockroach, a tortoise and a wise old owl! How fantastic! All photos taken can be seen on our Facebook page.






Our year 6 children have had an amazing time this week. All funds raised will go towards buying books and improving the story shed and treats for year 6. Thank you for your support.

If you are in receipt of certain allowances, your child may be entitled to free school meals. Please see our website page "Free School Meals" for more information and to find out how to check if you are eligible.


