Dying for a dip?

Every year people drown in open water around Greater Manchester.

It's not worth the risk, be safe around water.

<u>Please take care over the Summer if your child goes</u> <u>near open water.</u>

There are many dangers of swimming in open water.

There is no supervision, the water is cold, the water can be deep, there may be hidden currents and you cannot know what lies beneath.

What should you do if you get into difficulty?

However you end up in the water, if you end up in difficulty, float to live:

- Tilt your head back, with ears submerged.
- Relax and try to breathe normally.
- Move your hands to help you stay afloat.
- It's okay if your legs sink, we all float differently.
- Spread your arms and legs to improve stability.

If the effects of cold water shock pass and you regain your calm, take the next step to safety. This could be swimming to a safe place, calling for help or holding onto something to help you float.

If you see someone in difficulty in the water remember 'call, tell, throw':

Call 999 and ask for fire if inland or the coastguard if by the sea. Explain your location clearly and describe any landmarks.


Tell the struggling person to try to float on their back.

Throw them something that floats.

MEANWOOD SCHOOL UNIFORM STANDARDS

The school uniform at Meanwood is:









• In summer, girls may wear a blue gingham dress and boys may wear short grey trousers

For safety reasons, children are not permitted to wear jewellery except plain stud earnings - these will need covering for PE if they cannot be removed by the child.

For indoor PE children need plain dark coloured shorts/leggings and a plain white t-shirt.

For outdoor PE plain dark coloured shorts/leggings, plain white t-shirt and trainers.

For **outdoor PE** (COLDER MONTHS) plain dark coloured tracksuit/fleece bottoms, plain jumper and trainers

Children will need a pump bag to store their PE kit. Long hair must be tied back for PE.

Children will also need a **water bottle** and a **bag** that is brought to school every day to hold items such as a reading book, homework and letters.

PLEASE ENSURE ALL ITEMS ARE CLEARLY LABELLED WITH YOUR CHILD'S FULL NAME

Refer to our website under Parents—School Uniform for further information regarding suppliers of LOGO items.

The cost of school dinners will be increasing by 10p from 4th September. The new price will be £2.50 per day. The weekly cost will therefore be £12.50.

If you are in receipt of certain allowances, your child may be entitled to free school meals. Please see our website page "Free School Meals" for more information and to find out how to check if you are eligible.


A total of 53 children were late this week, compared with 48 last week.
