Year 6 pupils who are going to a Rochdale school will be going directly there and all Meanwood children will be moving up to their new class and meeting their new teacher and staff team. You should have received a letter last week informing you who your child's new teacher will be. The new teacher in Year 5 will be Miss Woods and the class will be 5W.

Please be reassured that if your child is in a split year group class e.g. 1/2 or 3/4 they will be taught the curriculum for their year group - there will be no detriment to these children.

Children will go to their new classes from drop off at 8:45am (please see plan attached) and will go back to their current classes before lunchtime so you will collect them from the normal place at home time at 3:15pm. Children will be shown where they need to go with their teacher before Tuesday so they will be able to show parents/carers where their new door will be.

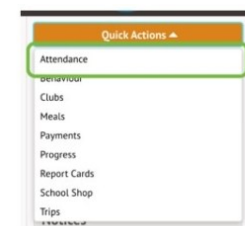

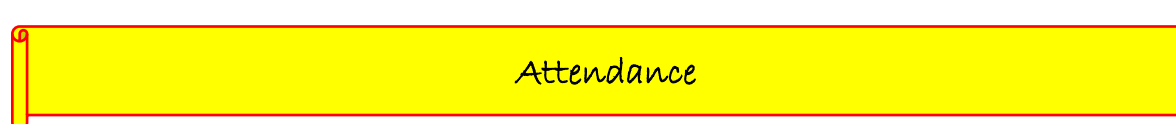

School fines for unauthorised absence have changed.

The government (Department for Education) has introduced a new national framework for penalty notices which parent/carers must pay if they take a child out of school during term time, for holidays or unauthorised absence. The changes came into effect for fines issued after 19 August 2024. We urge parents/carers not to interrupt their children’s schooling and talk to the office staff before booking leave of absence.
