



#### MOVE UP MORNING—TUESDAY 1ST JULY 2025


On Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> July we are having our Move up Morning!

Year 6 pupils who are going to a Rochdale school will be going directly there and all Meanwood children will be moving up to their new class and meeting their new teacher and staff team. You should have received a letter last week informing you who your child's new teacher will be. The new teacher in Year 5 will be Miss Woods and the class will be 5W.

Please be reassured that if your child is in a split year group class e.g. 1/2 or 3/4 they will be taught the curriculum for their year group - there will be no detriment to these children.

Children will go to their new classes from drop off at 8:45am (please see plan attached) and will go back to their current classes before lunchtime so you will collect them from the normal place at home time at 3:15pm. 
#### **REPORTING A CHILDS ABSENCE**


