SWIMMING LESSONS (YEARS 3&4)

Years 3&4J will be starting their swimming lessons on **Wednesday 4th December**. Please ensure you send your child to school with swimming kit on this day each week. This will be instead of their PE lesson.

Swimming is <u>compulsory</u> and is part of the national curriculum, so ALL pupils must go each week.

Years 3&4B have now finished their swimming lessons and start PE lessons on *Wednesday 4th December*. Please ensure that your child has their PE kit in school for this day each week.

Years 3&4C will now be having their block of swimming lessons last, so will not be going until after the *February half-term*. The official date will be confirmed closer to the time. Please ensure that your child has their PE kit in school for their PE lesson each Wednesday.


Schoolgateway

School fines for unauthorised absence have changed.

The government (Department for Education) has introduced a new national framework for penalty notices which parent/carers must pay if they take a child out of school during term time, for holidays or unauthorised absence. The changes came into effect for fines issued after 19 August 2024. We urge parents/carers not to interrupt their children's schooling and talk to the office staff before booking leave of absence.
