# <u>Information</u>

#### **Nursery Children**

Please send your Nursery children in a warm coat and strong footwear every day. We often go outside and all need to be well wrapped up for the weather! Pull on, zip up or Velcro footwear are preferable to laces, thank you. Please also make sure your child has a pair of mittens rather than gloves, as gloves are a little bit too difficult for the children to manage at this age. Many thanks.

# **Electric scooter and bikes**

School cannot stop children keeping electric scooters and bikes in the bike shed however unfortunately you are leaving it at your own risk. School is not liable for any stolen or damaged property in the bike shed.

# Is it illegal to ride a kid's electric scooter?

Under UK law, e-scooters, alongside hover boards and electric unicycles, are considered "powered transporters". This classification means that it's illegal to use them on pavements, cycle lanes or in pedestrianized areas. You would only be able to use your new scooter on your own private property.

#### What are the rules on electric scooters?

Currently, you cannot use either adult electric scooters or kids electric scooters on public roads, pavements, cycle lanes, cycle paths or in other public spaces. In the UK, it is illegal to use an electric scooter on public property.

# Future intake of children at Meanwood

We have been approached by the Local Authority as they have identified that the birth rate in our locality is dropping and as such there are too many school places available. The LA has opened a consultation which started on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> December which all staff, governors and parents/carers are urged to consider as this will affect the future intake of places at Meanwood. The proposal is to drop the PAN (Published Admission Number) from 60 to 45 for the Reception intake in September 2024. Other local schools are also in consultation to reduce their numbers too; Meanwood is not the only school in the borough to be affected.
