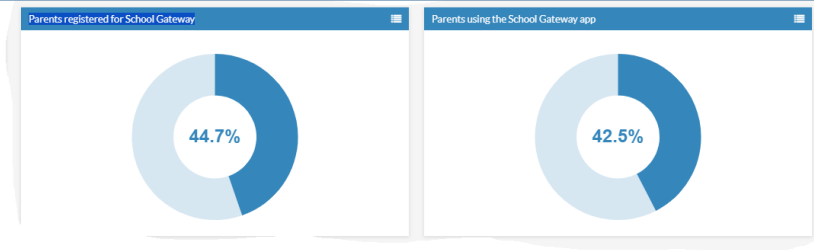


School Gateway is our parent app that allows you to pay for school trips and dinner money. It also enables you to select your children's dinner meals, book after school activities and communicate with the school at anytime from anywhere.

Please note: you must book your children's dinner choice at least one day before the meal date. You cannot book on the actual day.

All school related communication, emails and messages will go through School Gateway. To stay up to date with what is going on at school please ensure sure you download the app on your mobile phone – it is free.

At present, only 44.7% of parents have registered and only 42.5% of parents are using the app.
We need your help to make this work.
