NEW MOBILE PHONE RULES IN SCHOOL

The Government have issued schools with new guidance regarding children bringing mobile phones into school. If your child has to have a mobile phone in school, please remind them that they must bring the phone to the school office at the beginning of the day for safe keeping, and that it must be switched off.

There will be an Easter Egg prize for the best decorated egg from each class.




Reception Stay & Play
