We would like to take the opportunity to remind all of our school community about the information we have on the school website https://www.melbourne-inf.derbyshire.sch.uk/our- school/safequarding on how we keep our children safe online. We are aware in this Covid-world that we are asking the children and you to be increasingly connected through technology, and especially with the up-coming holidays we would like to remind you all of the possible risks. We have noticed in school an increase in talk amongst the children around online games (Minecraft, Roblox etc.), Youtube videos and especially songs and dances from TikTok. Please note that these games, apps and websites are age restricted and do not have the filters in place that we use in school. We encourage you to talk to your children about these things, to have a system in place in your families where the children can talk to you if they have concerns and to spend time online with them to see whether you feel they are appropriate for the age of our children, https://www.internetmatters.org/resources/ has all the information you need.
