Absence and Sickness Reporting

If your child is absent from school, please ensure you ring the school office on 01332 862325 before 9.00 am each day stating

- your child's name
- the name of your child's class
- the specific reason for absence (at this current time we need more information than feeling poorly)

Please be reminded that if your child is sick or has diarrhoea, they must remain away from school until 48 hours after the last episode.

On the same note we ask that you do not send your child to school if they have symptoms consistent with Covid 19 this includes a temperature, cough, loss of taste or smell. You will need to book a PCR Covid test and inform the school of any results before your child returns to school.

Polite notice - If your child has been absent due to illness, please ensure that they are fully recovered before sending them back to school.
