<b>Fine Motor Workshop</b>	Wednesday 14 <sup>th</sup> May, 9.15-10am	Come in and join us for fun with fine motor activities! This workshop is for parents and children to attend, younger siblings are welcome. Booking is not required.
<b>Story Time</b>	Wednesday 4 <sup>th</sup> June, 9.15-10am	Come in and join us for story time with the Infant School staff! This workshop is for parents and children to attend, younger siblings are welcome. Booking is not required.
<b>Tour of the School/Lunch</b>	Monday 16 <sup>th</sup> - Friday 27 <sup>th</sup> June : 11.30am start	There will be an opportunity for the child starting school, and one parent, to have a tour of the school and stay for a delicious lunch! <i>Please note that younger siblings are unable to attend the tour and lunch sessions.</i>  <b>Please book your preferred date for the tour by <a href="#">clicking or tapping here</a>.</b> There are limited slots for each date, and dates will be available on a first-come, first served basis. Please book sooner rather than later to reserve your preferred date/time.
<b>Induction Morning</b>	Tuesday 1 <sup>st</sup> July, 9.30am	The induction morning takes place on transition day for all schools in the local area (Infants to Juniors, Juniors to Secondary etc). <u>Where possible, we would encourage all families to attend the induction morning.</u> Your child is invited to come and meet their class teacher for our induction morning. Your child will remain in their class whilst you join the other parents in the school hall for a brief talk from the Headteacher. After the meeting you will then be able to return to the classroom to collect your child.
<b>Stay &amp; Play</b>	Thursday 10 <sup>th</sup> July, 9.15-10am	Come along and have a play with your child! It is also an opportunity to talk to the EYFS staff (no siblings please). No need to book: please just arrive and sign in at the school reception.
<b>Activity Afternoon (Pre-School)</b>	Thursday 3 <sup>rd</sup> July, 1.30- 2.30pm	Each year we hold an activity afternoon for the new children (attended by children only). <b>Arrangements are made by the local pre-school your child attends.</b> If your child does not attend a local pre-school and you would like your child to come along, please let school know & you may accompany them for this.
