Year 13, if you completed your UCAS application by 30th June and are still awaiting a decision from any of your choices, universities and colleges have until the 17 July to make an offer. You then have until 24 July to reply to any offers you receive. In the unlikely event that you don't get any offers at this stage, you can still use Clearing.

Year 12, from 10 July 2024, you can make your <u>application to</u> <u>conservatoires</u> for courses starting in 2025. UCAS offer an application route to nine UK conservatoires – each has its own strengths and specialisms, so it's important that you do your research to find the right fit for them.
